**LAWATAN RASMI TYT H. PRABOWO SUBIANTO, MENTERI PERTAHANAN
REPUBLIK INDONESIA KE MALAYSIA**

**14 NOVEMBER 2019
Kuala Lumpur**

YB Haji Mohamad bin Sabu, Menteri Pertahanan Malaysia telah menerima kunjungan daripada TYT H. Prabowo Subianto, Menteri Pertahanan Republik Indonesia sempena lawatan rasmi beliau ke Malaysia pada 14-15 November 2019. Lawatan ini merupakan lawatan rasmi pertama ke luar negara oleh TYT H. Prabowo Subianto selepas dilantik sebagai Menteri Pertahanan pada 23 Oktober 2019.

Sempena lawatan rasmi ini, YB Haji Mohamad bin Sabu telah mengadakan perbincangan dua hala dengan TYT H. Prabowo Subianto dengan kedua-dua pihak mengesahkan komitmen untuk terus mempertingkatkan kerjasama pertahanan sedia ada bagi kepentingan bersama dalam mencapai keharmonian, kestabilan dan kemakmuran di rantau Asia Tenggara.

Dalam pertemuan tersebut, kedua-dua Menteri turut bertukar pandangan mengenai isu yang mempunyai kepentingan strategik dan operasi bagi kedua-dua negara. Landskap keselamatan global yang dinamik turut disentuh oleh kedua-dua Menteri dan ancaman keselamatan bukan tradisional khususnya ancaman keganasan menjadi fokus utama bagi kedua-dua pihak.

YB Haji Mohamad bin Sabu dan TYT H. Prabowo Subianto memperakui bahawa lawatan rasmi ini mencerminkan hubungan pertahanan dua hala yang erat dan dinamik antara kedua-dua negara. Lawatan rasmi ini juga turut mengesahkan komitmen Indonesia kepada Malaysia sebagai rakan pertahanan utama di rantau ini.

Kerjasama pertahanan antara Malaysia dan Indonesia terutamanya di antara Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM) dan Tentera Nasional Indonesia (TNI) telah lama terjalin dan giat berkembang melalui Jawatankuasa Am Persempadanan yang telah ditubuhkan pada tahun 1972. Hubungan pertahanan ini turut diperkukuhkan melalui beberapa inisiatif keselamatan sub-rantau seperti *Malacca Straits Patrol* (MSP) dan *Trilateral Cooperative Arrangement* (TCA) yang melibatkan Filipina.

Hubungan dua hala antara Malaysia dan Indonesia disifatkan sebagai satu hubungan yang rapat dan lawatan rasmi ini akan terus menyumbang kepada pengukuhan hubungan persahabatan antara kedua-dua negara.

**OFFICIAL VISIT BY HIS EXCELLENCY H. PRABOWO SUBIANTO, MINISTER
OF DEFENCE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
TO MALAYSIA**

YB Mohamad bin Sabu, the Minister of Defence Malaysia hosted an official visit by His Excellency H. Prabowo Subianto, Minister of Defence of the Republic of Indonesia on 14-15 November 2019. This is the first official visit abroad by His Excellency H. Prabowo Subianto after his appointment as the Minister of Defence on 23 October 2019.

During the official visit, YB Mohamad bin Sabu held a discussion with His Excellency H. Prabowo Subianto in which both Ministers expressed their shared commitments to further strengthen the existing defence cooperation based on mutual interests and towards achieving peace, stability, and prosperity for the Southeast Asian region.

Both Ministers had a very productive discussion covering a broad spectrum of defence strategic matters and operational interest to both countries. They also deliberated on concerns regarding the dynamic global security landscape, focusing on non-traditional security threats particularly terrorism, which is the highest of their priorities.

YB Mohamad bin Sabu and His Excellency H. Prabowo Subianto acknowledged that the official visit is a testament of the strong and dynamic bilateral defence ties between both countries. This visit also reaffirmed Indonesia's commitment to Malaysia as a key defence partner in the region.

The defence tie between Malaysia and Indonesia has seen excellent progress under the ambit of the General Border Committee (GBC) that was established in 1972, especially between the Malaysian Armed Forces (MAF) and the Indonesian National Armed Forces (TNI). The defence relation has also strengthened through sub-regional initiatives namely the Malacca Straits Patrol (MSP) and the Trilateral Cooperative Arrangement (TCA) together with the Philippines.

Malaysia and Indonesia share a close bilateral relation and this official visit is a vital step to further strengthening the existing bond of friendship between both countries.
